Site Organization

The CECR website is organized so that users can find and view materials two ways—by content area (e.g. program evaluation) and product type (e.g. podcasts). Using the three main tabs on the homepage, website users can easily navigate to materials they need.

- The **green** Perspectives on Compensation Reform tab arranges all of the CECR materials by content area
- The **orange** Compensation Reform in Action tab gives background information and resources on alternative compensation initiatives and news across the country
- The **blue** TIF Grantees tab has useful information for and about TIF Grantees, as well as a repository of our materials organized by product type

As a TIF Grantee there are certain pages that will be especially helpful to you. Most of them are found on the blue TIF Grantees tab.



Glossary of Materials

- **Guide to Implementation:** Comprehensive guide to assist TIF grantees and other stakeholders in the design, operation, and evaluation of educator compensation reform efforts.
- **Emerging Issues:** Discussion of key topics in educator compensation reform.
- **The Harvesting Project Papers:** Findings from the CECR data harvesting project that discuss lessons learned from the first two cohorts of TIF Grantees.
- **Case Summaries:** Highlights from alternative compensation programs from conception through implementation.



- **Other Videos:** Video presentations on alternative compensation topics, including value-added and information systems.
- **Webinars:** Web-based forums hosted by CECR that provide grantees with information on different components of TIF and performance-based compensation.

• **Podcasts:** User-friendly, concise audio files that share information on a variety of popular alternative compensation topics, including evaluation, information systems, and communication.



- **Research Syntheses:** Short responses to key program design and implementation questions using research-based studies and other relevant information.
- **Presentations/Papers:** PowerPoints and handouts from presentations given at CECR events, and various research papers related to educator compensation reform.



- **National Map and Map Profiles:** Map of the US displaying educator compensation reform efforts nationwide, along with accompanying descriptions of programs in place.



- **Annotated Bibliography:** Annotated bibliographies with publications grouped by topics related to educator compensation reform.

- **Newsletter:** Monthly newsletter that shares the latest news, research, and discoveries regarding compensation reform.
