Philadelphia TIF

- Housed in the *Office of Charter, Partnership and New Schools*
- Implemented in charter schools (individual LEAs)
 - 4 schools in Year I
 - 11 schools in Year II
 - 11 schools in Year III
- Uses TAP Model
 - Distributed leadership
 - A train-the-trainer model
 - Leadership teams
 - Administrators, master teachers and mentor teachers
 - Teacher professional development
 - Performance-based pay incentives

- 6 school districts
- 23 schools
 - 9 Elementary Schools
 - 6 Middle Schools
 - 5 Elementary/Middle School Combinations
 - 2 High Schools
- Approximately 900 teachers
- Approximately 12,000 students
- Uses the TAP model
